


OUR HIGH CAPACITY PLANT IN PANIPAT

Our state - of - the - art factory in Panipat, India, is part of our continual efforts to exceed your expectations. It is designed to streamline operations, smoothen material movement, maximize productivity and meet exceptional standards of quality. It conforms to the latest international specifications and is benchmarked against the biggest and best in the global handmade rug industry. The facility includes a 52,000 sq. ft. Production area and a 25,000 sq. ft. Drying area. It also has eco-consciousness built in, with solar panels to reduce power consumption and a rainwater harvesting system to preserve the water table. We have helped increase green cover in the locality by planting trees around the factory. As with all our products and facilities, the new plants have all the social, ethical, safety, health and process certifications.

To support what is said above and improve our working, we have built a new factory beside the previous one, comprising of a yarn godown of 10,000sq. ft. and a weaving unit of 25,000 sq. ft. that includes 7 broadlooms, 20 pit looms and 3 frame looms."

EXTENDED FACTORY AND IN-HOUSE YARN GODOWN










Weaving Area

The fully equipped Weaving area in the extended factory houses Broadlooms, Pit looms and Frame looms, along with a fully dedicated finishing and inspection floor, thus increasing our manufacturing capacity. A dedicated team of quality control managers regularly inspect and keep a tight check on the products developed by our efficient master weavers. The finished samples are subjected to quality checks through the Metal detector machine and the TWF Machine. The in-house production of samples in the specific weaving area has helped improve production efficiency, while simultaneously enabling a continuous check on the quality of the products under development.









In-House Yarn store

The New Yarn Store space added to the new factory, is a catalyst for the sampling and production department. The area has been specially designed keeping in mind, the placement of the vast variety of the yarns kept and stored according to the their respective composition. It also provides the exclusive room for yarn bank, making it easy for a newcomer or a layman to know about the variety of yarns that can be used in creating unique products. The provision of specialized yarn testing lab with different testing machines ensures the quality of every yarn used in our products. The Twist Tester Machine assures even twist of the yarns procured from across the globe, and the Tensile Strength Tester Machine confirms the quality of the yarn stocked.

NEW FACILITIES AT OUR PLANT





Drying chamber

The new auto-controlled drying chamber has the capacity to latex and dry three rolls simultaneously in a single cycle. It has been specially designed to handle rolls up to a width of 5 metres, and has the highest safety standards. This significantly reduces the risk of delays or incomplete drying of rolls during the monsoons and winter season, thereby enhancing productivity.

Dyeing house

The dye house is equipped with ultra modern and sophisticated dyeing equipment for yarns meant for rugs and carpets. The computer controlled dyeing facility, with cabinets ranging from 15 Kg to 1 ton, has a capacity of about 200 tons per month and can handle wool and viscose yarns.

The facility is supported by a precision lab equipped with the latest version of photo-spectrometer which can detect colour variation of Δ e<1, which is undetectable by the human eye. This is supported by latest versions of colour-matching, recipe derivation software and IR dyeing which can simulate and validate colours before beginning bulk dyeing, minimising batch to batch colour variations.

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








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















Soft Tacticality


Fantastic Flora and where to find them
